






## A WORD FROM THE PRINCIPAL

work or further study, and our alumni prove we are achieving our vision of transforming lives.


As we strive for beyond outstanding, our brand and reputation, as well as the quality and financial position of the College, underpins our ability to recruit students and engage with external audiences.

## **AWARDS AND ACCOLADES 2017/18**


Over the year we were delighted to receive many awards and accolades for our staff, students and Barnsley College as a whole. This recognition of the great work the College does is a boost for the whole town.

- · Our Marketing, Communications and PR team was highly commended in the Website Development category at the College Marketing Network national FE First Awards.






















### **OUR STUDENTS**

95% said the teaching on their course was good.


**91%** of our students go on to work or further study after competing their course.
