

Get ready for Criminology

About the subject

Criminology is the scientific study of crime. The course covers a wide range of topics within the area of Criminology.

In the first year you will compare the difference between crime and deviance, analyse different types of crime and look at how the media impacts on the public perception of crime. You will combine all of this knowledge to design your own crime awareness campaign. In addition, you will also study explanations of criminal behavior and apply some of these theories to real life criminals.

In the second year, you will research different crime investigation techniques and also learn how evidence is collected, processed and used during the trial process.

If you are interested in studying Criminology at university, or are looking at a career in the police, law or other areas of the criminal justice sector then this course is suitable for you!

Your tasks
